Introduction:

The Battery backup for PSP keeps the game playing by let you power your PSP devices(or NDS · GBA). It's a great solution for long plane flights, or hikes, or for anytime you don't have access to an AC outlet. The battery pack uses for standard "AA" rechargeable batteries that you can simply replace when the charge is gone. The battery pack incorporates a power-low indicator, so you can tell ahead of time when your batteries are running low.

Features:

- Provides up to 3-5 hours for PSP game time ※ 1, 3
- Provides up to 1-1.6X for PSP battle life ※ 1, ※ 3
- Includes 4 AA batteries, for virtually unlimited playing time
- Indicates Power Low LED
- Support 1.2V battery ※ 2, ※ 3
- Not support 1.5V battery ※ 4

※ 1: Use the Ni-MH rechargeable 1.2V, 2100~2500mA battery

※ 2: Recommend use Ni-MH rechargeable battery 1.2V, 2100~2500mA or more,

※ 3: No recommend using Ni-MH rechargeable battery 1.2V, 1800mA or less, the battery power is too low.

※ 4: Carbon-zinc dry & alkaline battery is 1.5V, and the battery power is too low.

Installing:

1. Insert 4 AA batteries (included) into the battery compartment of the battery pack



2. Connect the USB charge cable to the battery pack by plugging the USB charge USB-A type connector into the USB port of the battery pack.



3. Connect the battery pack to the PSP by plugging the battery pack DC connector into the DC IN port of the PSP.

4.To use the battery pack's batteries, side the on/off switch to the on position. The PSP now received power from the battery pack.



5.When the red LED of the battery pack is flash, the battery pack's batteries is low, please change the 4 AA batteries

6.when devices is NDS 、 GBA, please use the USB charge cable for NDS 、 GBA.
